HCDC is partnering with Harrison County ISU Extension & Outreach to sponsor Grant Writing 101. Grant Writing 101 will provide hands-on training in seeking and writing successful grant applications. Representatives of nonprofits, local government, schools and other organizations are encouraged to register for Grant Writing 101, which will be presented online by Iowa State University Extension and Outreach staff from 1 to 4 p.m. on Thursday, April 15.

There is no fee for the workshop, but class size is limited and registration is required by April 12. Register by calling the Harrison County Extension Office at 712-644-2105.
